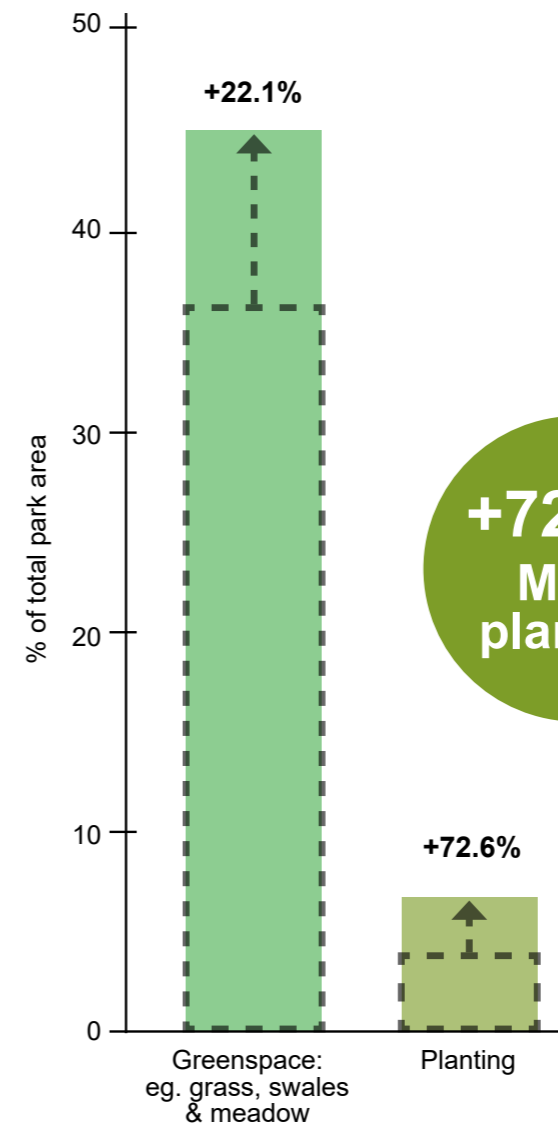
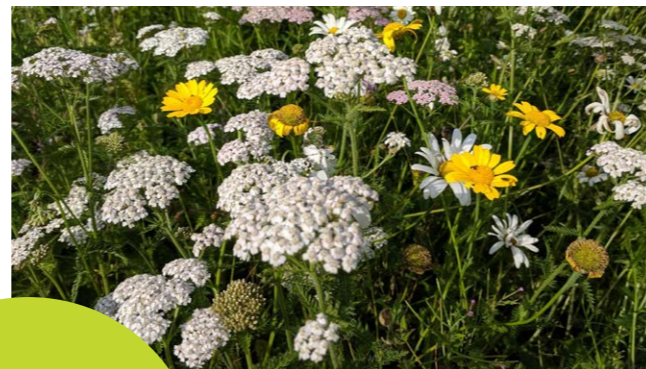
An increase of 38 native and ornamental flowering trees.
