

## Statement of Representations Procedure – Islington Local Plan consultation on main modifications June 2022

The Council is inviting representations on main modifications to the Draft Local Plan The Draft Local Plan is at an advanced stage following several rounds of consultation and was submitted to the Secretary of State for Independent Examination in February 2020. The Examination Hearings took place between September and October 2021. Following the Examination Hearings, **from 24 June until 7 August 2022** the council is inviting representations on main modifications to the following documents:

- Strategic and Development Management Policies this sets out strategic policies for the whole borough to identify where and how change will happen and detailed policies to manage development.
- Site Allocations this sets out site specific policies for a number of sites across the borough which will contribute to meeting development needs.
- Bunhill and Clerkenwell Area Action Plan this is the plan for the south of the borough, covering the majority of Bunhill and Clerkenwell wards, where significant change is expected to occur over the plan period. It also includes site specific policies for this part of the borough.

The council will also provide the contact details of those who make representations to the Programme Officer (who is responsible for organising and managing the Local Plan Examination and is independent of the council) so they can be kept informed of the Examination process.

## Representations must be submitted by 23:59 on 7 August 2022.

Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specified address of any of the following:

- a) the publication of the recommendations of the person appointed to carry out an independent examination of the local plan under section 20 of the Act, and
- b) the adoption of the local plan.
