Being development comprised within Schedule 2 Part 3 Class PA of the said Order namely:

"Development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class B1(c) (light industrial) of the Schedule to the Use Classes Order to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule"

and not being development comprised within any other class.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Land shown only shaded grey on the attached plan and being designated Vale Royal / Brewery Road Locally Significant Industrial Site by Islington's Development Management Policies Development Plan Document adopted June 2013, policy DM5.3 and shown on Islington's Local Plan Policies Map – June 2013.
