

## Islington Place Survey – National Indicators

The following table sets out the National Indicator scores from the Place Survey for Islington. A total of 1542 people took part in the Place Survey in Islington, though not all answered each question. London comparisons, the Islington rank in London and the 2006 BVPI score for Islington where available are also included.

Note: the data is still provisional as the final, confirmed scores are yet to be published by the Department for Communities and Local Government.
