VET is currently able to offer funding to trainees through a variety of sources. All funding is conditional and has specific eligibility criteria.

LSC / ESF Funding for Freelances

Provides bursaries of 80% to freelances on a specific range of courses. They are:

VET currently subsidises freelances on a variety of Avid editing courses, where other funding is not applicable. We apply Skillset eligibility criteria to assess freelance status



London Development Agency Funding

Available to individuals and SMEs based in four London boroughs:
Hackney, Islington, Tower Hamlets and Camden

4LB (Bespoke Media Skills Training for the City Fringe)

Provides funding of between 50 - 95% to people living in the four City Fringe boroughs (listed above) for training designed to improve job retention, career progression or work opportunities. There is an application process to establish eligibility with deadlines at pre-set dates. Through a training needs analysis, a training plan is agreed with successful applicants. Trainees must attend at least five days of training in total. It is likely that business skills training will be part of the plan. VET can agree that training covers more than five days

Digital A / V

Provides ca. 75% funding on a 5 day package of learning opportunities for people living and/or working in the City Fringe boroughs. Can cover training courses or supported facilities services. Conditions apply. Targeted at small and medium sized enterprises (SME) with fewer than 250 employees and freelancers. Bursary awarded upon successful application

ERDF

TECH IT / EAST

Provide support to individuals and SMEs residing in parts of seven East London boroughs to experience and explore high level technologies like broadband, DVD, HDTV and QTVR for their work. The seven boroughs are: Hackney, Newham, Tower Hamlets, Bexley, Barking and Dagenham, Greenwich and Havering.
