Dear Resident or Trader,

Highbury Square traffic calming review

After requests from residents, the council agreed to remove speed humps where residents expressed a concern about noise and vibration from construction vehicles accessing the new Highbury Square development.

We have already removed some speed humps and speed tables from Aubert Park, Avenell Road and Drayton Park. We will be introducing alternative traffic calming measures where these speed humps have already been removed. The three existing speed humps on the works route in Aubert Park will be removed in stages and at each stage will be replaced with a road narrowing.

We are doing this because there was concern that the remaining speed humps should not be removed without something put in its place at the same time to retain the levels of safety in the road. If the speed humps were removed immediately there could be an increase in danger to road users, since there would be no traffic calming measures left in this part of Aubert Park.

The speed humps in Aubert Park that are being removed and replaced are:

- outside 29 Aubert Park;
- outside 68 Aubert Park; and
- outside Westerdale Court, Aubert Park.

The proposals involve the introduction of road narrowings at some of the locations where the speed humps are removed and a 20mph speed limit on some roads (please see plan). These are intended to discourage speeding by drivers and should not affect the amount of parking available on the road.

Please let me have any comments on the proposals by 31 May 2007. If there are no objections, we hope to start work at the start of June and expect it to take around four weeks to complete.
