- First degree; Higher degree; NVQ levels 4 and 5; HNC; HND; Qualified Teacher, Medical Doctor, Dentist, Nurse; Midwife.
- Working age is 16 - 64yrs inclusive for men and 16 - 59yrs for women.
- Caring for those with long-term ill-health.
- Part-time is working under 30 hrs/week.
- Including part rent and part mortgage.
- Includes flat over a shop.
- Public transport users in households.
- They may also be (re-)married
- '-1' implies one room too few.
- Have not worked since 1999 or earlier.
- Lone parents with dependent children.
