

ADOPTION STATEMENT

LONDON BOROUGH OF ISLINGTON

PLANNING OBLIGATIONS SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 (as amended), notice is given that the London Borough of Islington adopted its Planning Obligations Supplementary Planning Document (“SPD”) on 16th July 2009.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Planning Obligations SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.

The Planning Obligations SPD sets out details of the Council’s policies on planning obligations, information on standard obligations and charges and the procedure for agreeing a Section 106 (S106) agreement. The SPD replaces the Section 106 Community Benefits Supplementary Planning Guidance (SPG) document adopted in 2003.
