

Using StreetNet

Instructions to connect to StreetNet using a wireless enabled PDA
The following instructions are for use as a general guide only. They are designed for PDA's running on a Windows operating system with in-built Wi-Fi capability. Individual machines and operating systems may vary. Please refer to manufacturers guides for full instructions.

Connecting to StreetNet

1. Click "Start"
2. Click "Programs"
3. Select the tab "Wireless Manager"
4. Click "WLAN"

The PDA should now automatically search for available wireless networks. These will be displayed in a pop up box.

5. If you have previously connected to StreetNet, click "OK" to connect again
6. If this is the first time you have connected to StreetNet, select "StreetNet" and click "Connect"
7. Click "OK". You will now be connected to StreetNet

Connecting to the Internet

StreetNet is available along Holloway Road and Upper Street, between the Odeon cinema on Holloway Road and Angel tube.

1. Click "Start"
2. Select "Internet Explorer"
3. If you have previously connected to StreetNet, go to 4. If not, search for a website e.g. www.google.co.uk

4. The following pop-up will appear. Select “Yes” to continue



5. The StreetNet front page will appear. Click on “full web access”

6. Click “Login” to begin. If you are prompted with another dialogue box, click “Yes” to continue.

Disconnecting from StreetNet and re-connecting to another network (i.e. GPRS)

1. Click “Start”
2. Click “Programs”
3. Click “Wireless Manager”
4. Click “WLAN” to disconnect from StreetNet
5. If required, click “GPRS” to re-connect to the GPRS network.

Instructions to connect to StreetNet from your Mac

Connecting to StreetNet

StreetNet is available along Holloway Road and Upper Street, between the Odeon cinema on Holloway Road and Angel tube.

1. Click the phone icon to reveal the drop down menu below. Click "Open Internet Connect"



2. Click the “AirPort” icon in the toolbar (circled below).

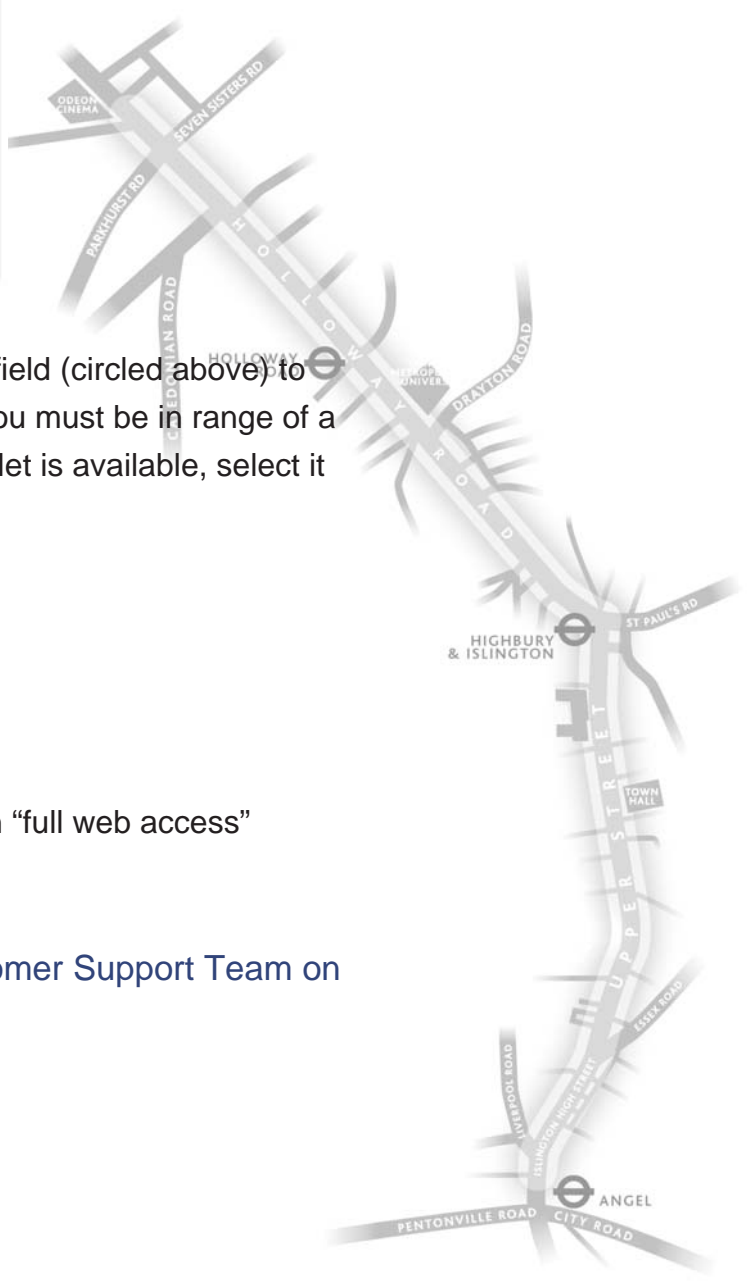


3. Click the up/down arrow next to the Network field (circled above) to reveal a list of available networks in range. You must be in range of a StreetNet wireless point to connect. If StreetNet is available, select it from the list.
4. Click “Connect”.

Connecting to the web

1. Connect to the Internet via Internet Explorer
2. The StreetNet front page will appear. Click on “full web access”
3. Click “Login” to begin.

Instructions to connect to StreetNet from your laptop

The following instructions are for laptops running on Windows XP with in-built Wi-Fi. These instructions are for use as a guide only, individual machines may operate differently. Please refer to manufacturers guides for full instructions.

Connecting to StreetNet

StreetNet is available along Holloway Road and Upper Street, between the Odeon cinema on Holloway Road and Angel tube.

1. Activate your laptops Wi-Fi power by pressing the wireless power button. The button will show the universal symbol for Wi-Fi as displayed here.
2. Click "Start"
3. Click "Control Panel"
4. Select Network and Internet connections (If your laptop is set to display "classic view" go straight to 5)
5. Select Network Connections
6. Right click "Wireless Network Connection"
7. Select "View available wireless networks"



This will bring up a list of available wireless networks in range. You must be in range of a StreetNet wireless point to connect. If StreetNet is available, double click to connect to StreetNet.

Connecting to the web

1. Click “Start”
2. Select “Internet Explorer”
3. The following pop-up will appear



4. Select “Yes” to continue
5. The StreetNet front page will appear. Click on “Free Internet access”
6. Click “Login” to begin
