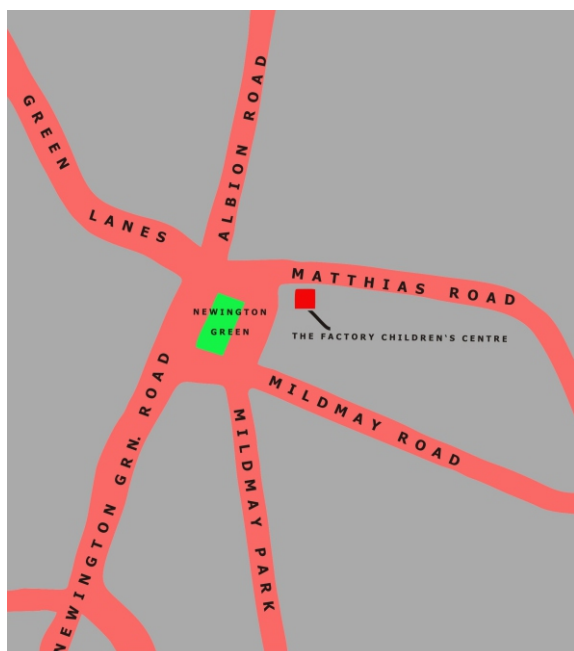


## HOW TO FIND US

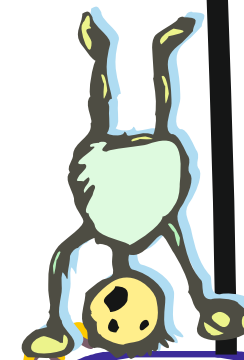
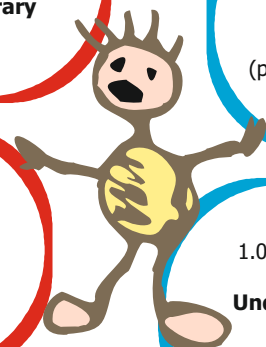
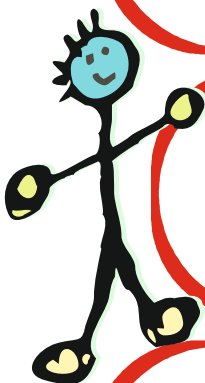
