### The types of physical traffic calming measures being proposed are:

#### Round Top humps

- The most effective way of slowing all vehicular traffic
- Will not result in any loss of parking



#### Speed cushions

- Allows buses and emergency vehicles to straddle the measures, causing minimal discomfort to passengers
- Less effective than speed humps in slowing down vehicular traffic, especially motor bikes.
- Will not result in any loss of parking



#### Raised zebra crossings

- Raised zebra crossings make them more visible and encourages drivers to slow down.
- Parking spaces can be lost due to zig-zag markings to keep crossing clear.



#### Entry treatments

- These provide a raised crossing point for pedestrians
- Tactile paving is provided to aid crossing movement of vulnerable road users, especially those who are visually impaired.



It is important to note that as well as being an effective traffic calming measure, speed humps may create an increase of noise levels if large vehicles travel over them. They could also slow response times for emergency vehicles.

## HILLRISE WEST 20mph Zone



### Dear Business/Resident

February 2006

As part of the Council's policy to reduce accidents and to provide a safer walking environment, the Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph zone in the Hillrise West area.

The aim of the scheme is to reduce vehicle speeds, traffic volumes and road traffic related accidents in the area through the use of traffic calming measures. The area has been identified as a priority as there have been 37 accidents reported between 2002 and 2005. New 20mph zone signs will be placed at all entry points to the zone. As part of this scheme, it is also proposed to carry out minor footway and carriageway repairs where possible, and to remove any excess street clutter in the area. The result of the proposed scheme is to provide an overall safer and more pleasant environment for vulnerable road users, namely pedestrians and cyclists.


As a resident/business in the area, your views are important to us. All responses received to the consultation will be used to assess whether the scheme should be implemented. Should the scheme be approved for implementation, work is expected to commence in **Summer 2006**.

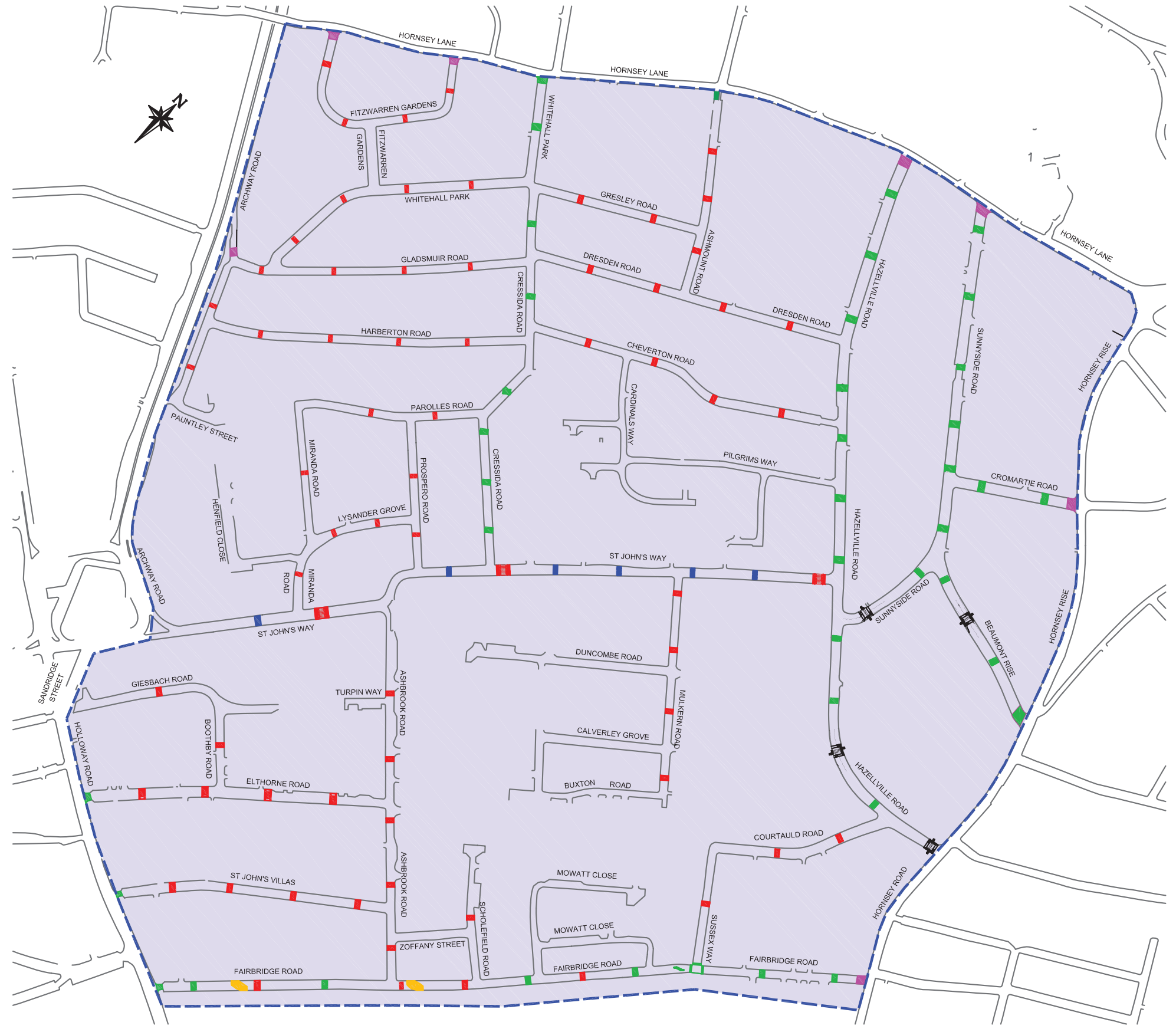
