One of the Council statutory duties is to take measures to prevent and reduce the frequency of road traffic related accidents. The Government has set national targets for reducing the number of people killed or injured in road accidents. These targets to be met by 2010:

- to reduce the No. of people killed and seriously injured by 40%
- to reduce the No. of children killed and seriously injured by 50%, and
- to reduce the No. of people slightly injured by 10%

In response to this, the Council has developed a policy to reduce accidents and to provide a safer walking environment. It is in line with this policy that the local safety scheme in Junction Road is being proposed

Proposal descriptions

- Raised entry treatment**
 - Acts as a traffic calming measure by slowing vehicles speeds when approaching the junction
 - Help to aid pedestrian crossing movements by providing a level crossing facility.
- Kerb build outs**
 - Designed to improve pedestrian sight lines, improving safety when crossing Junction Road
 - Will reduce the carriageway distance for pedestrians when crossing the road
- Pedestrian crossings**
 - Provides an informal crossing facility for pedestrians
 - Will include the provision of tactile paving
 - Will require some loss of parking provision
- Traffic Island**
 - Designed to help to reduce traffic speeds on Junction Road
 - Will help segregate moving traffic
 - Will not result in any loss of parking

Junction Road Local Safety Scheme



Dear Business/Resident Take part in the consultation on the future of your area.

The Council is proposing to implement a new local safety scheme in Junction Road.

Junction Road has been identified as a priority for safety improvements due to the high number of accidents occurring in the area. A total of 60 road traffic related accidents were reported along Junction Road between 2003 and 2005. Almost half of these accidents resulted in injury to pedestrians, with a quarter of all casualties being classified as serious.

The aim of this scheme is to reduce the number of accidents occurring in the area through the implementation of improved pedestrian facilities, providing an overall safer environment for vulnerable road users. We would like to hear your views on the proposals outlined in this leaflet. If the scheme is approved, works will commence in October 2005 and will be funded by central government following a successful bid by the Council.

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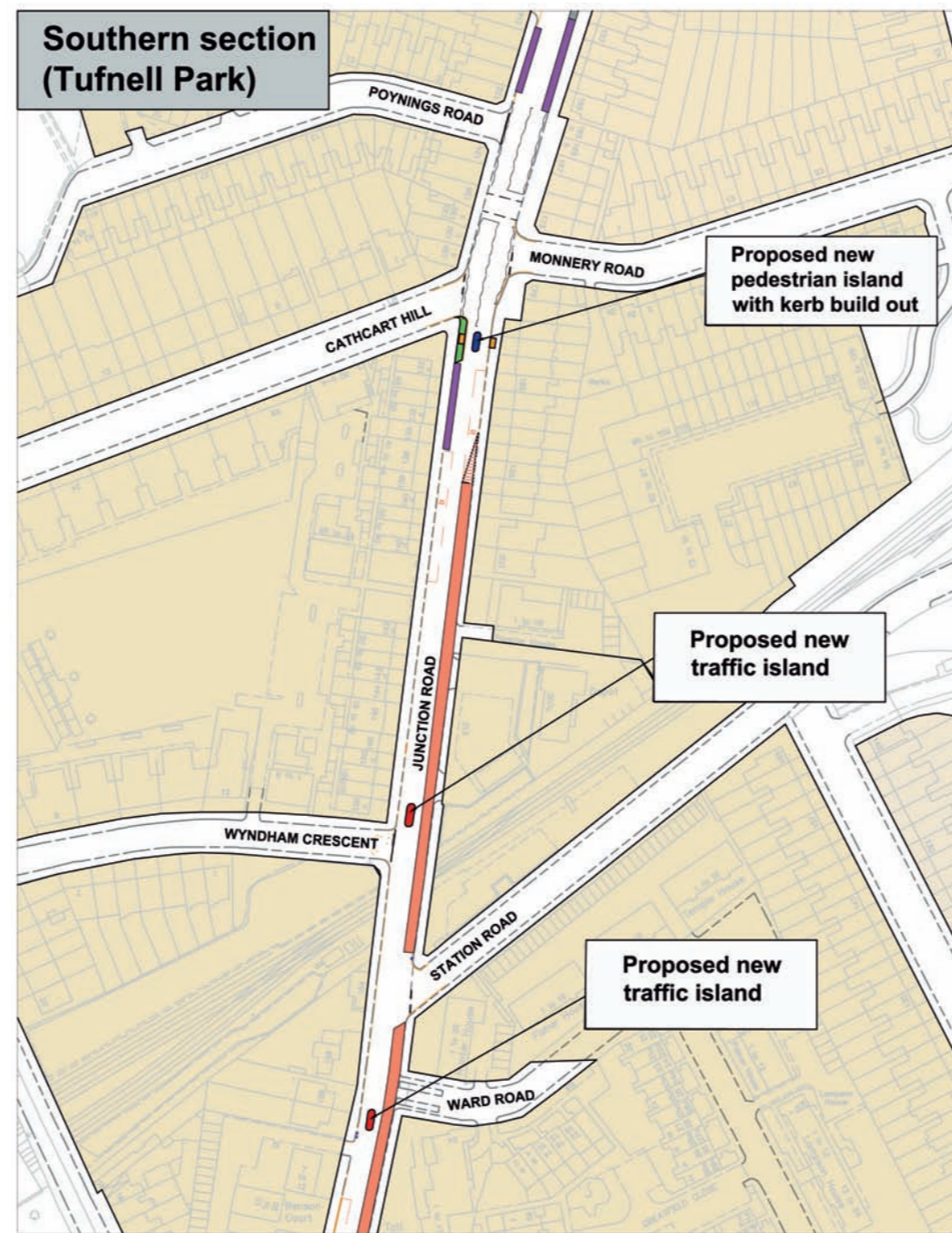
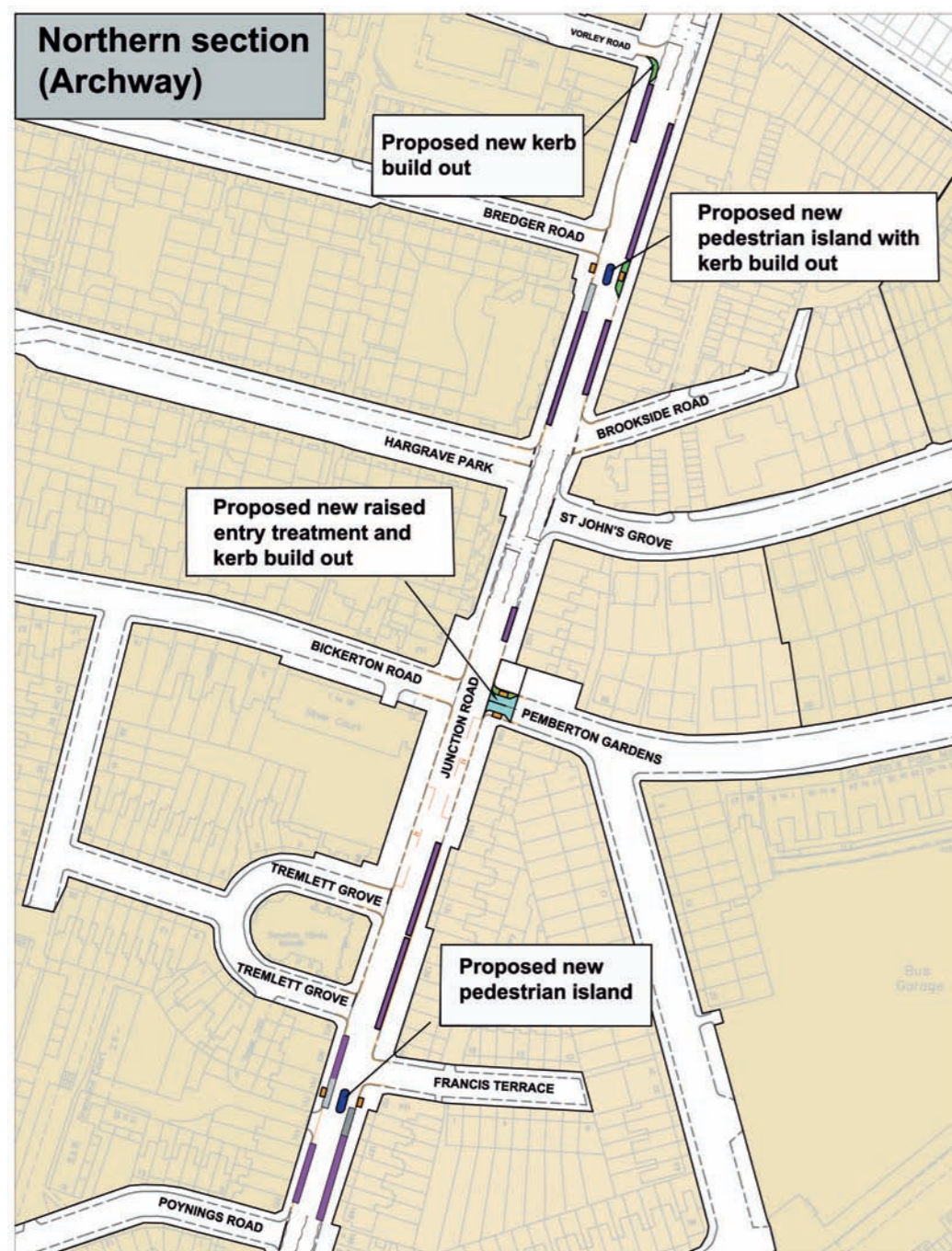
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Cornwallis 20mph zone and Local Area Lorry Ban
