

Highway Repairs

In March 2011, Islington was awarded £143,296.00 from the Department for Transport as a contribution to repairing potholes resulting from the extreme weather conditions. Islington currently spends £937,000 on reactive highways maintenance; this additional funding has been used to carry out patch repairs to complement our capital renewal programme of £1.4million. The streets that have benefited from this additional funding are listed below.
