



Disabled Persons' Blue Badge Guidance Sheet

It is very important that you fill in your application form carefully. Please make sure that you give as much detail as possible about your disability/illness and you provide the following documents and relevant supporting evidence (**photocopies are accepted, the council cannot be held responsible for original documents that go missing in the post**):

- **Proof of your residence** (ONE of the following – utility bill less than six months old, Council Tax bill, Driving Licence, Islington Council Tenancy Agreement, DWP letter.
- **Two passport size photographs** (one will be kept for our records and one will be used on your Blue Badge).
- **Your signature** in the two white boxes on the back page of the Application Form.
- **A copy of a Certificate of Entitlement letter (Disability Living Allowance) at the HIGHER RATE FOR MOBILITY (help with getting around) or War Pensioners Mobility Supplement, showing the period of the award.**
- **Proof of identity – a copy of one of the following: Passport, Birth Certificate, Driving Licence or Freedom Pass.**
- **Any supporting medical evidence from a Consultant or a hospital (if no disability allowance for mobility is held).**
- **Blind Registration Card or BD8 form/CVI.**

When your Blue Badge application is received and you are a first time applicant you may not automatically qualify for the Blue Badge. If this is the case we will contact you in writing with regards to the next stage of the application process.

If you have attended a council mobility assessment when you last applied for your blue badge then it is likely that you will be asked to have your mobility reassessed for the renewal of your Blue Badge. It is therefore important to return your application as soon as possible as any delay may cause you to be without your Blue Badge whilst waiting for the assessment process to take place.
