1	Crime and ASB with Natalie Jones	
1.1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 15 burglaries in the past 2 weeks no discernible pattern to these ➤ There has been a marked increase in theft from motor vehicles, thefts of blue badges – Advice is to avoid leaving valuables visible in your car and if you are a blue badge holder and parked in your local area to make use of free disabled parking permits available from Islington Council. ➤ Thieves have also been using car jamming locks to gain access to vehicles ➤ There has been an increase in rough sleepers around Margret Grove area ➤ Delinquents have been congregating around Conrad and Beckford house and have been gaining access to the communal parts of the building by kicking the intercom this has been averted by moving the intercom to a higher position ➤ There has been an increase in ASB around Gillet square – this will need to be referred to Hackney as this is within this borough ➤ St Judes Street park – lots of issues with ASB, drug use, drinking, urination and defecation – PCSO Jones agreed that more patrols around this area will be needed and that any law breaking/ threatening behaviour should be reported via 999 if the perpetrators have left then a report should be made via 101 ➤ Smart water was also available to residents if they wish to mark their valuables as this helps to return stolen items when/ if they are recovered ➤ Please make use of social media to report issues to the your local police the next door website and twitter pages are regularly checked

2.1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Fair Future Commission was set up to ensure that every child regardless of back ground is able to achieve their full potential full report can be found at the following link. • The Commission Chair was Jermain Jackson and Cllr Kadeema Woodbyme was the deputy chair • Main themes were: being protected, support systems, possibilities, being life ready • 250 interviews with young people, organisations that work with young people and adults who work with children took place. • The report highlights the importance of support during adolescence. • The report concluded that by the time a child turns 16 they should have had at least 100 hours of experience to make them ready for the world of work. This can include work experience or skills based training. • The report also highlighted the need for more interconnected communities as a means to curb social isolation. Particular areas of concern were for the wellbeing of care leavers and children who are the primary carer of their parents. • The report raised concerns that children have including but not limited to: the high cost of housing and overcrowding. • The report called for more child friendly spaces, the removal of no ball game signs and the improvement of play areas
