- **Hornsey Road** – after shops closed bit of TLC needed/ waste collection
- **Welby House** – Needs a bit of TLC , nothing for children to play with
- **St John's Way** – Dog Fouling
- **Dulas Place, Tollington Park** – dog fouling on patch of grass next to the nursery, playground next to Dulas Place is permanently closed.
- **Cornwallis Square Gardens** – broken glass/rubbish

There was also a survey given out to everyone who came on the day asking what key things they would like our new community centre to focus on.

The result was:

- **First Priority:** Activities for children – trampolining, gymnastic, outdoor space, dance classes, indoor sport, activities at weekends, youth club and Stay & Play for under 5's.
- **Second Priority:** Activities for elderly – sewing, ballroom dancing and lunch club.
- **Third Priority:** ESOL classes.

Recommendations:

What we recommend:

- 1) View the grot spots that have been noted to see what needs to be cleaned or repaired;
- 2) Find out why the Dulas Street playground is closed and see if it is possible to be opened again and renovated;
- 3) Arrange a further survey with respondents and identify the 5 “most popular” activities they would like in the new community centre;
- 4) As part of the neighbourhood plan, include community engagement events such as coffee mornings and drop in sessions. Once agreed, include on Hanley Crouch website.
