



Updates from last meeting and response to AOB provided by Councillor Kay.

1. The development of Hathersage Court has been paused while a new heating system is installed. Hopefully work will start in the Summer/Autumn.
2. I have asked the police on two occasions (once when Cameron was the PC) and then again at the latest Mildmay Police Ward Panel to be more vigilant about people cycling on pavements, particularly on Newington Green and the Mildmay Groves. They have confirmed that they fine people £30 when they see them.
3. I have also asked them to do more around Paradise Fish and the Kebab shop opposite. These are regular targets because they are still predominantly cash businesses. The people who run the shops have little confidence in the police so a lot goes unreported but greater patrols are necessary. I also mentioned that I am working with NGAG and local businesses to improve that area (outside the Acoustic).
4. Overly loud motorbikes can be classed as ASB by the Police. The Met site says that *"Driving or riding in this way can also be used as a form of intimidation, either to other road users or the community. Loud noise from engines and music, and deliberately creating large amounts of exhaust or tyre smoke can also be seen as an aggressive act."* So anyone who sees this again should report the license to the police.
5. Improvements to the crossing at Newington Green have been funded and are in the Council's work programme. There have been delays but we are now back on track. Consultation will start after the mayoral elections.
6. The Street Cleansing manager has confirmed that the shift has been altered to not coincide with peak commuting hours. Please tell people to get in touch with me directly if they are still experiencing issues.
