1. Forms of nomination for Borough Elections may be obtained at Electoral Services, Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London, N1 2UD from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Electoral Services, Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London, N1 2UD on any day after the date of this notice but no later than **4 pm on Thursday, 9th April 2026**.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 7th May 2026**.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Monday 20 April 2026**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London, N1 2UD by **5pm on Tuesday, 21st April 2026**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote.
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate (free voter ID, or an Anonymous Elector's Document) valid for this election, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London, N1 2UD by **5pm on Tuesday, 28th April 2026**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London, N1 2UD by **5 pm on Tuesday, 28th April 2026**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity, for work/service or Voter ID reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services, Islington Town Hall, Upper Street, London, N1 2UD by **5pm on Thursday, 7th May 2026**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday, 28th April 2026. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Tuesday, 28th April 2026.
