

A realistic look at council housing and your options

We want to be realistic about your chances of being housed or rehoused. Not many properties become vacant each year.

Last year we only let 1186 properties, housing just 8% of people on the housing register.

Over 40% of these homes were studios or one-bedroom properties.

Many people have told us that if they realised how long the wait for council housing is, they would have considered other options when they first applied, like swapping homes or renting privately.
