As far back as 1972 I used to visit a company Kingshill Electronic Products in Torrens Street (see photo). In fact their sign is still fixed to the wall although they moved to Dartford area must be 35 years ago. The building was always of great interest to me as it was at one time a multi-story stable block with specially design stairs so that the horses could be walked up to various floors. I guess the building must go back to the 1800's. I would be disappointed to think that it would be pulled down and consider it to be probably the only one of its type left [even in the UK] and should be carefully re-purposed – it would make a great artisan centre and fit in very well with the Angel image. I know the building looks grubby in the photo but it must have great potential.
