

Planning ahead for any home visit



Before any home visit read Camden and Islington Public Health Home Visits Guidance



- Is your visit essential or can it be delayed?
- Always try to call ahead to find out if it is safe to visit and risk assess the need for PPE.
- If not possible to telephone, ask risk assessment questions before entering the premises.
- Ensure you carry PPE with you in case it is needed.

Risk assess the need for PPE. Questions to ask:

- Is anyone shielding?
- Does anyone have a cough or temperature?
- Is anyone in the house self-isolating?
- Has anyone in the house been discharged from hospital in the last 14 days?

Please remember, when interacting with people at home always...



Keep a minimum distance of 2 metres where possible.



Wash hands frequently (for at least 20 seconds) or use a hand sanitiser with a minimum of 60% alcohol.



Clean surfaces frequently including door handles, rails, hoists etc.



Avoid touching your face, nose and eyes.
