

Pride and Islington – The Data

In 2021, the most recent census for England and Wales was completed, this included some of the most complete data ever to exist on our LGBTQIA+ population. What does the data show:

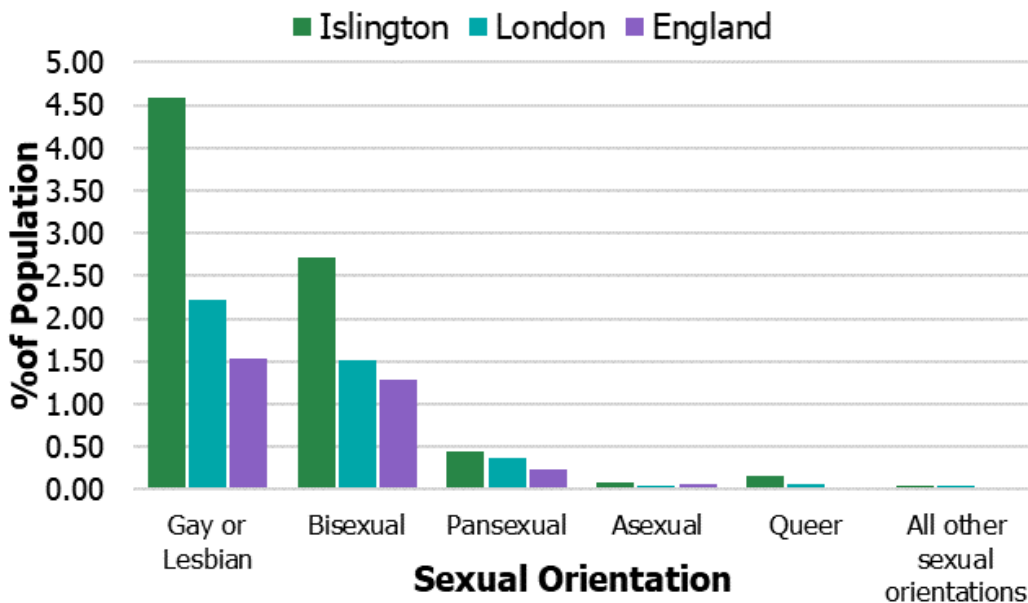
Sexual Orientation

8.0% of Islington residents identify as LGB. This was greater than the proportion in London (4.3%) and England (3.2%).

Islington has the 4th highest proportion of residents who identify as LGB when compared to all London boroughs.

Islington has the 5th highest proportion of residents who identify as LGB when compared to all local authorities in England and Wales.

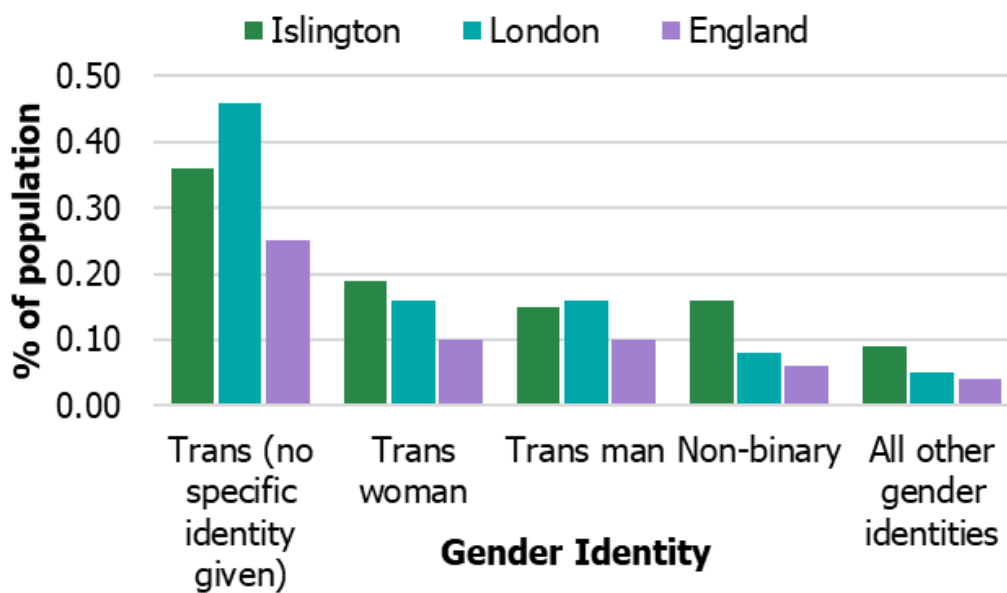
Gender Identity

1.0% of Islington residents identify as trans. This was greater than the proportion in London (0.9%) and England (0.6%).

Islington has the 14th highest proportion of residents who identify as trans when compared to all London boroughs.

Islington has the 22nd highest proportion of residents who identify as trans when compared to all London boroughs.
