Parenting Programme:

PaFT Programme is opened to all Kate Greenaway families. It is an early childhood parent education and family support programme serving families from pregnancy to 3 years old. The families decide whether they would like to have weekly, fortnightly or monthly personal home visits or appointment at the KG Centre. During these visits, we share age-appropriate child development information with parents, address their parenting concerns, will inform parents of what they can reasonably expect of their child at each stage of his/her development. We will also give you information about different ways to stimulate your child's development and learning. For further information, please contact KG.
