
Finsbury Leisure Centre - new build proposals

We are in the early stages of looking at providing a new leisure centre, a new medical centre, better and safer public spaces and building much-needed new council homes around Finsbury Leisure Centre. This newsletter outlines our early proposals.



We are holding several consultation events, in-person and online, to discuss these proposals. Please join us at one of these events, you can meet the architects and project team, find out more about the proposals and ask questions. We hope to hear from as many people as possible who live and work locally and use local services, to help shape our proposals and develop them further.

Our initial proposals take into account the feedback received from previous local consultations. No decisions have been made yet and this is your opportunity to tell us what you think and to help us shape these proposals.

Islington Council is committed to tackling the current housing crisis, including building 750 new council homes across Islington.


Priority for local people

Priority for the new council homes will be given to social housing tenants living in the Bunhill ward who meet the lettings criteria and are looking to downsize, live in overcrowded properties or who have needs that are not being met in their current homes. We'd like to discuss our initial proposals to:

- Build more than 180 new homes including 100 much-needed new council homes. Ideally, all the new homes we build would be council homes but we sell some of the homes we build to pay for the overall scheme
- Improve leisure facilities replace Finsbury Leisure Centre with a new, state of the art health and wellbeing hub for the community, including a doctor's surgery
- Create safer, accessible and more welcoming open spaces including pedestrian streets across the site, improving the look and feel of the area
