### Consultation on Islington's Site Allocations Development Plan Document

We are currently reviewing Islington's Site Allocations Development Plan Document (DPD). This document sets out policies for how we can make the best use of sites to serve Islington's growing population and workforce.

We have identified over 150 potential sites where new housing, workspaces, shops, open spaces, or leisure and community facilities could be provided over the next 15 years. We would like to hear your views on the sites and uses we are proposing between **12 February** and **26 March 2018**.

#### Where are the sites?

This notice has been placed near sites we are proposing to allocate. The sites are largely concentrated in those parts of the borough which are likely to see the greatest amount of change over the next 15 years:

- Archway
- Finsbury Park
- Nag's Head and Holloway Road
- Highbury Corner and Holloway Road
- Angel and Upper Street
- Vale Royal and Brewery Road Locally Significant Industrial Site
- King's Cross and Pentonville Road
- Bunhill and Clerkenwell
