**Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 No.767**

**Notice of Adoption of Development Plan Documents (Regulation 26)**

On 27 June 2013 Islington Council adopted the following Development Plan Documents ('DPDs'):

1. **Site Allocations** – policies for specific sites across the borough where new housing, work places, community facilities and open space could be created;
2. **Development Management Policies** – guidelines for making decisions on planning applications across the borough; and
3. **Finsbury Local Plan (Area Action Plan for Bunhill and Clerkenwell)** – this is a 15 year plan to manage future population and economic growth in this part of the borough.

All three DPDs form part of Islington's Local Plan and will be used in making decisions on planning applications. They have been examined by an independent Planning Inspector and have incorporated the Inspector's recommended modifications.

The DPDs, their Sustainability Appraisal reports, the Inspector's reports detailing the modifications, and the adoption statement can be found:

Any person aggrieved by any or all of the DPDs may make an application to the High Court under section 113 Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act, 2004 on the grounds that—

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any application must be made not later than the end of the period of six weeks after the date of adoption.
