**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) (ENGLAND)
ORDER 2015 AS AMENDED**

NOTICE OF DIRECTIONS UNDER ARTICLE 4(1)

Notice is given that on 21 January 2019 the London Borough of Islington confirmed a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) ("the Order") to withdraw the Permitted Development right for change of use from offices to dwellinghouses (the Direction).

The Direction withdraws the permitted development right granted by Schedule 2 Part 3 Class O of the Order being development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class B1(a) (offices) of the Schedule to the Use Classes Order, to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of that Schedule.

The effect of the Direction is that once it comes into force, the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the development specified above and such development shall not be carried out within the areas to which the Direction applies, unless planning permission is granted by the Council. The Direction will come into force on 20 March 2019.

The Direction relates to the Central Activities Zone within Islington.
