Key messages



COVID-19 Cases in Islington

- As of 26 June 2020, a cumulative total of 541 laboratory confirmed cases in Islington have been reported since the pandemic began. This figure now includes positive results from pillar 2 testing. Pillar 2 testing refers to testing of people who are symptomatic in the community. Previously only pillar 1 cases were being reported.
- The number of new cases per day has been on an overall declining trend since mid-April.
- Islington has had the lowest rate of cumulative COVID-19 cases in London at 226 per 100,000 population.
- The availability of testing has increased over time, therefore many suspected cases would not have been tested early on
- There were 2 new cases reported between 20 26 June.


COVID-19 Deaths in Islington

- A total of 148 deaths in Islington have been COVID-19 related, up to 06 June 2020.
- There were no deaths related to COVID-19 reported in Islington between 30 May and 12 June 2020.
- In Islington, the number of COVID-19 related deaths peaked during the week of 4 April 10 April at 42 deaths and has fallen steadily since.

How many cases are in the borough?







Note: Date refers to date the first specimen was taken from the person being tested. Confirmed cases are from Pillar 1 and Pillar 2 testing.



- As of 24 June 2020, there are a total of **541** laboratory confirmed cases in Islington.
- The number of new cases per day has been on an overall declining trend since mid-April.
- 2 new cases were reported in between the 20th and 26th of June.
- The availability of testing has increased over time, therefore many suspected cases would not have been tested early on.





Cumulative case rate per 100,000 population, London boroughs compared to London and England, 26 June 2020



- Islington has had the lowest rate of cumulative COVID-19 cases at 226 per 100,000 population.
- This is lower than both the London and England averages (377 and 431 per 100,000 respectively)

Age standardised mortality rates





- The age standardised COVID-19 mortality rate in Islington is 131 per 100,000 population.
- This is significantly higher than the national rate (82 per 100,000), but similar to the London rate (138 per 100,000).



- A total of 148 deaths in Islington were COVID-19 related.
- In Islington, the number of COVID-19 related deaths peaked during the week of 4 April -10 April at 42 deaths and has fallen steadily since.
- In the latest week of available data (06 June 12 June), there were no COVID-19 deaths.
- Since the 9 May, the total weekly numbers of reported deaths of Islington residents has been lower than the average number of deaths reported 2014-2018.
