National Framework

The Islington Schools Forum was established under The Schools Forums (England) Regulations 2002, initially to be consulted by the relevant authority (the Council) on matters pertaining to the local distribution of school funding. Since April 2006, Forums have also acquired some decision-making powers.

DfE guidance states that while members of a Schools Forum are representatives of their specific sector or phase, they should be able to consider the needs of the whole of the educational community.

The Schools Forum, follows consultation with schools, agrees how the Schools Block funding of the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) is distributed between schools, and how much is retained centrally for specific functions. The role of the Forum has remained important, ensuring funding is allocated fairly across all schools and academies. Furthermore, the local authority shares policy changes and funding allocations across the remaining DSG funding blocks and actively seeks Forum's view on direction of travel.

Schools Group Members

The membership of the Forum is divided into the Schools Group: ie heads and governors, elected by their peers; and the Non Schools Group: ie representatives of the wider education community, appointed by the local authority.

Membership of the Schools Forum in Islington

The full membership of Schools Forum is set out overleaf for information. In July 2006 the Council's Executive agreed that the term of office for all members should be 4 years, with the option of extending for one year.

At Schools Forum on 16 January 2020, it was agreed that members could stand again for election after a first term of four years plus one year's extension – this was to ensure continuity of experience and knowledge. Further, Schools Forum agreed at that meeting that, in exceptional circumstances, a member could stand for a third term, but with no extensions for a year after this term.

It was acknowledged that it was important for the Forum to be open to new members and for the maximum term of office to be no more than 10 years. However, the Forum felt it needed to have the flexibility to allow for the longer terms of office where it would be in the interests of Islington schools and providers. One example of exceptional circumstances is where there are very few schools in a category – eg special school, pupil referral unit or nursery school.

At the meeting on 16 January 2020, it was also agreed that in future elections and appointments, only one representative will be allowed per school, hard federation or multi-academy trust.

The next two meetings are being held on Thursday 20 May and Thursday 15 July 2021, 2-4pm, virtually / on MS Teams.
