

## Getting started with Libby

The free Libby app is the easiest way to get started with digital books, e-magazines and e-comics if you are a member of Islington Libraries.

Libby is available for Android, iOS and in your browser at [libbyapp.com](https://libbyapp.com)

- Use your device's app store to install and then open the Libby app, or instead go to [libbyapp.com](https://libbyapp.com) using your browser.
- Follow the prompts to find **Islington Libraries** and sign in with your library card, using the full number starting 20120 and then the 4 digit pin. If you do not have an Islington library card you can [apply online](#) or pop into your [local Islington Library](#) to get one.
- Browse  or search  the collection.
- Icons next to the titles show whether they are available for loan immediately  or will need to be placed on hold to borrow later 
- Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf  and if you are accessing through the app, they download automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.
- On your Shelf, tap loans (at the top left of the screen). From there, you can:
  - Tap *Open in Libby* to start reading or listening in the app.
  - Tap *Manage Loan* to see options like Renew and Return.
